

Champetre County Gravel Tour May 31-June 1, 2025



Dates: Saturday May 31st & Sunday June 1st

Event: A gravel riding weekend event in Champetre County – Saskatoon Wild West Country Ranch in St-Denis. Champetre County is nestled in the rolling hills, 7 km north of St. Denis. It is approximately 40 km east of Saskatoon along Hwy 5. The above picture is typical of the beautiful Champetre countryside in summer.

Ride Start Times: Group rides on both Saturday and Sunday with start times at approximately **9:30 am** from Champetre County.

Lunch: Each participant should bring their own snacks, lunches and water along on the rides.

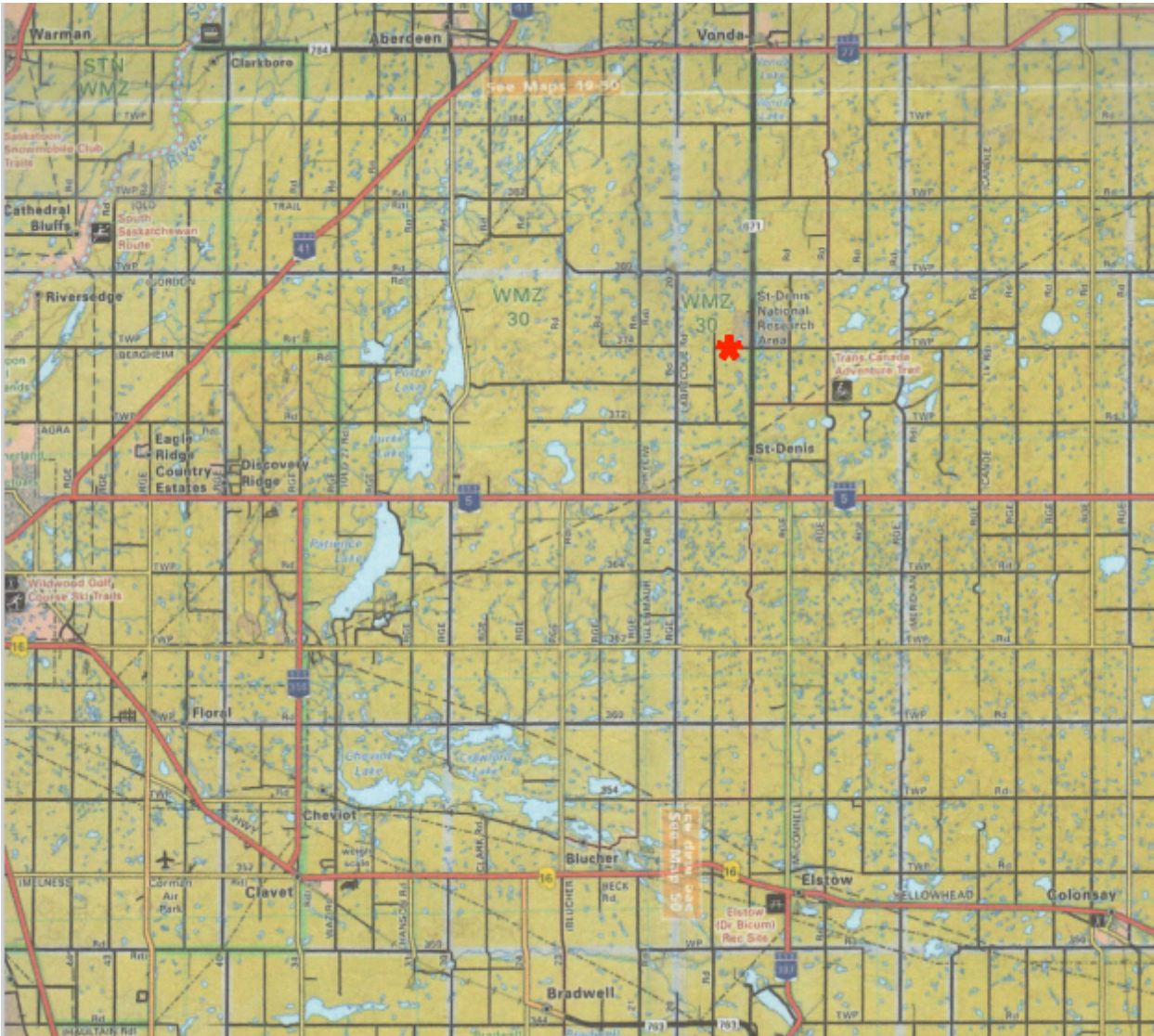
Ride Details: Saturday's Ride is planned to be a **60-80 km** ride and Sunday's ride is planned to be a **30-50 km** ride. Both rides will be on gravel and the aim will be to complete loops on both days if possible. There will be a ride leader each day with knowledge of the area and participants will be provided opportunities to explore the area in a group ride setting.

As this is a SCC Club ride weekend, all riders are required to follow the designated ride routes on both Saturday and Sunday.

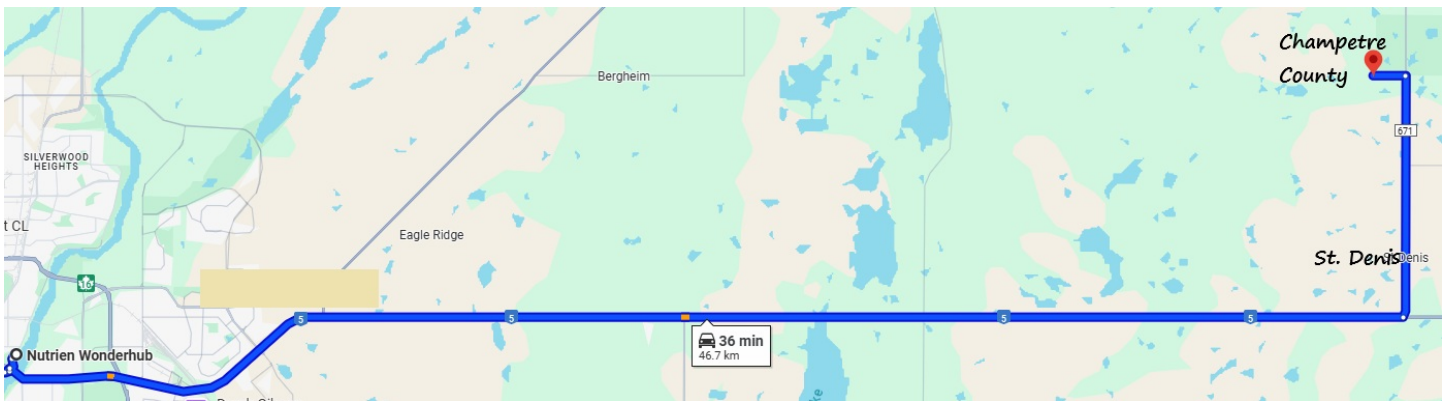
Riders must have an SCC or an SCA membership.

Accommodation Options:

Champetre County website is located at, <https://champetrecounty.com>. Champetre County has a range of different rooms, cottages, and cabins. The resort also has 30-amp electrical RV sites and a grassy tenting area.

Staying there is recommended because of the fun we had around a firepit in the evening, and soaking in the hot tub (that I hope is still in operation this season)!

If you decide to stay at Champetre Friday and/or Saturday night, you are responsible for booking your own accommodations directly online at <https://champetrecounty.com>. Online is the best way to book accommodation. Please book your accommodations as soon as possible as the Champetre is typically very busy in summer.

If you want to drive out for each ride instead, Champetre County resort is about 50 km east of Saskatoon, but it helps to be familiar with the route.

Group Meal Options at Champetre:

At Champetre there is a Saloon that can hold up to 150 people, a Town Hall that holds up to 300 people and the Chickadee Café that holds from 10-30 people. Their restaurant does not operate as a regular restaurant and hence they need to know ahead of time what dining option our group will be needing. Therefore, we offer the following group meals:

- Burger meal **Saturday, May 31st at 6 pm** **\$27.75** including taxes
- Breakfast **Sunday, June 1st 8 am** **\$18.87** including taxes
(Scrambled eggs, sausage, pancakes & toast)

NON-REFUNDABLE after May 16th.

This gives Champetre time to plan the meal.

A gratuity can be paid in person while at Champetre.
